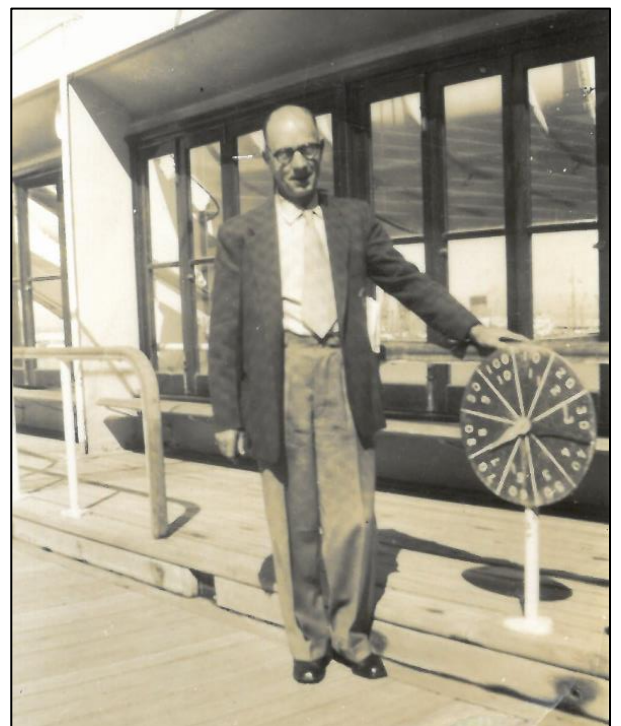

ALL: **Amen.**

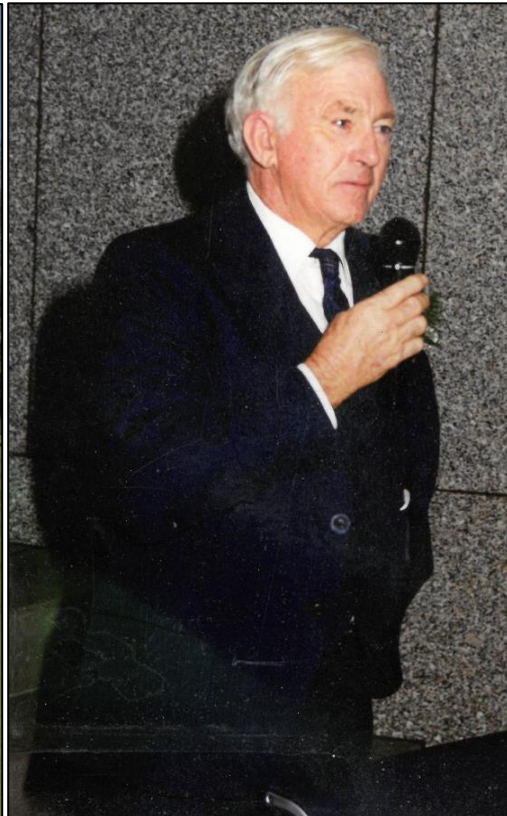
FINAL COMMENDATION AND FAREWELL
