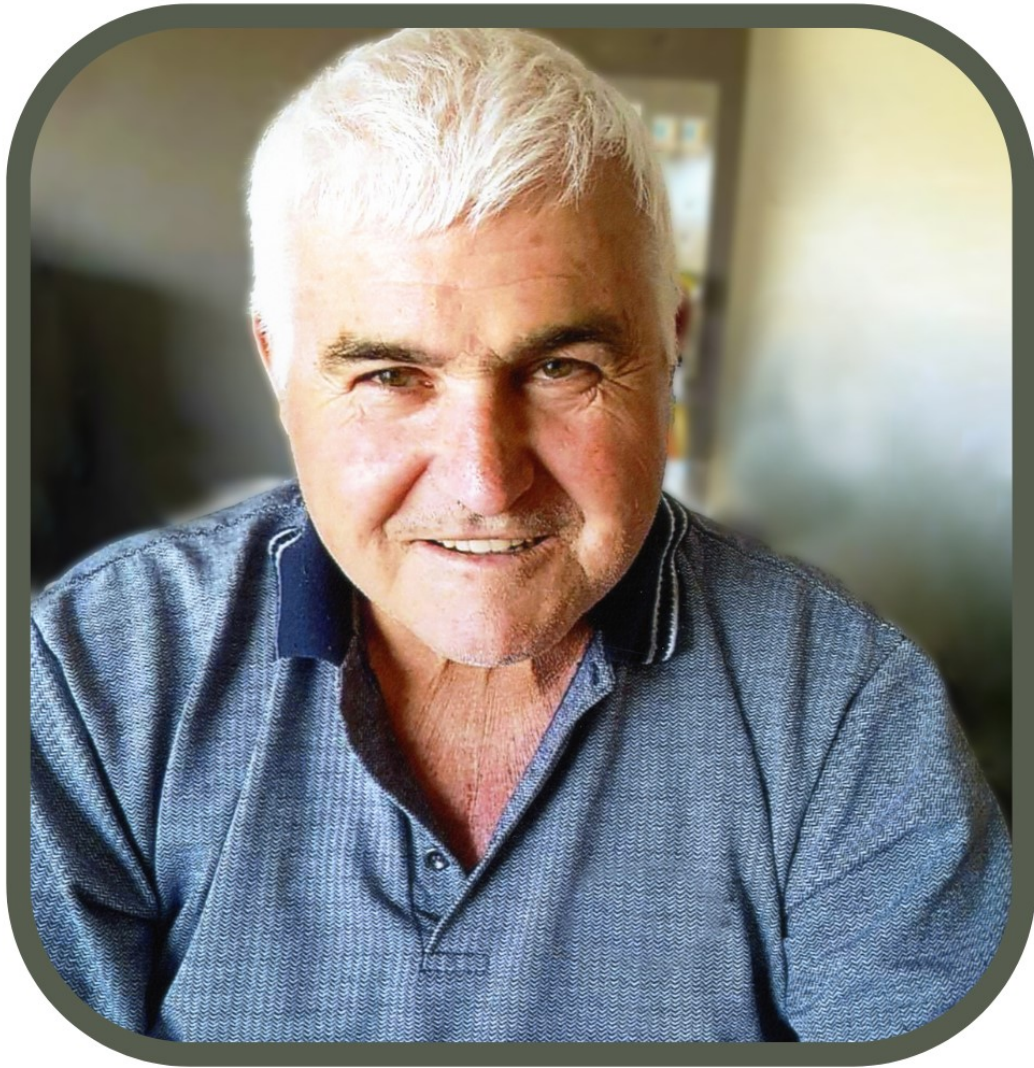

Fr Cyprian: May he rest in peace.

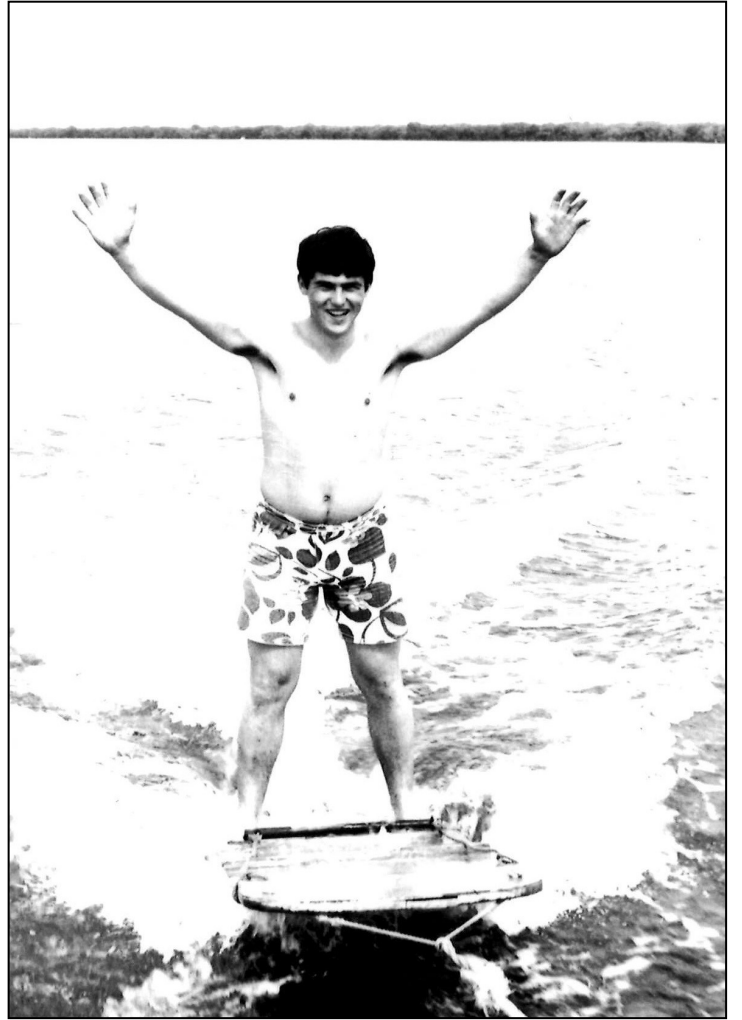
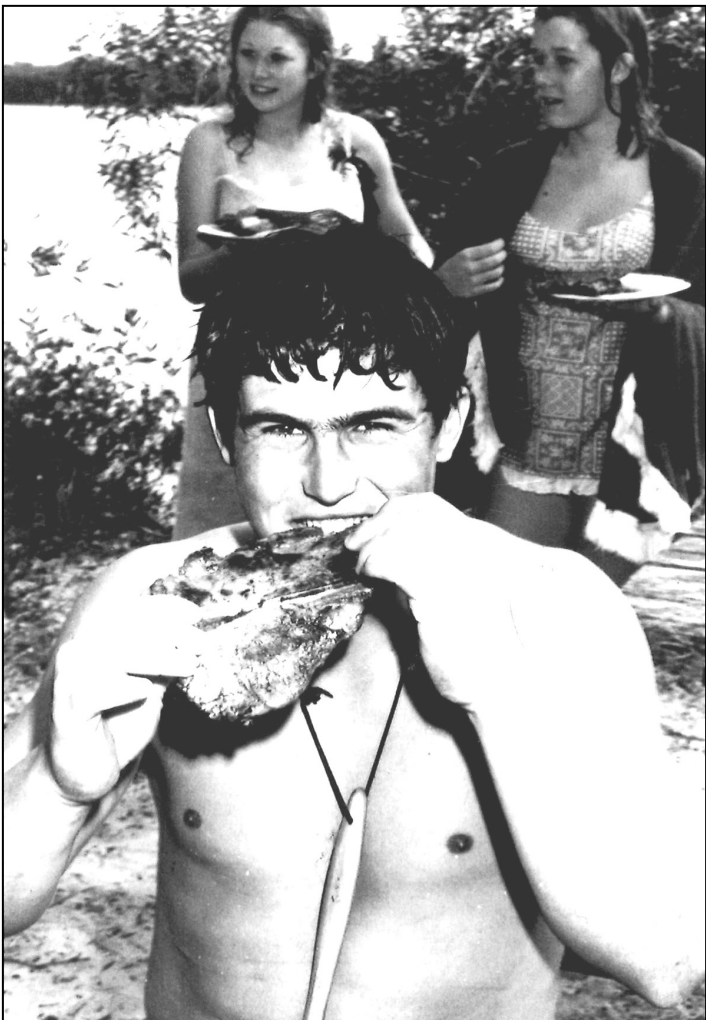
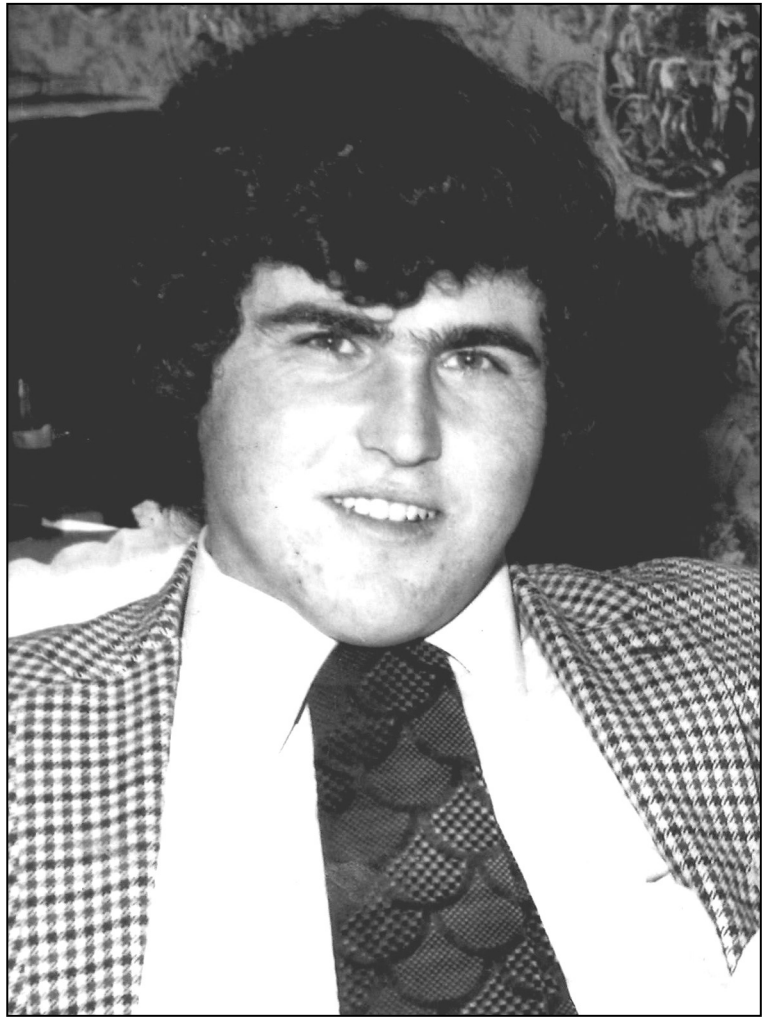

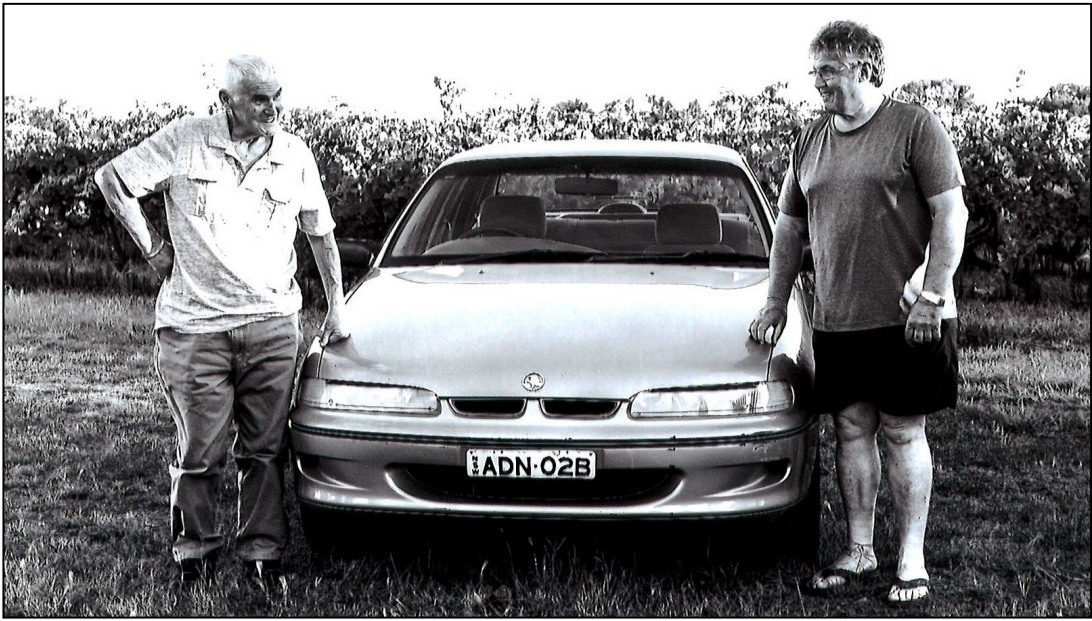
Fr Cyprian: May his soul and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

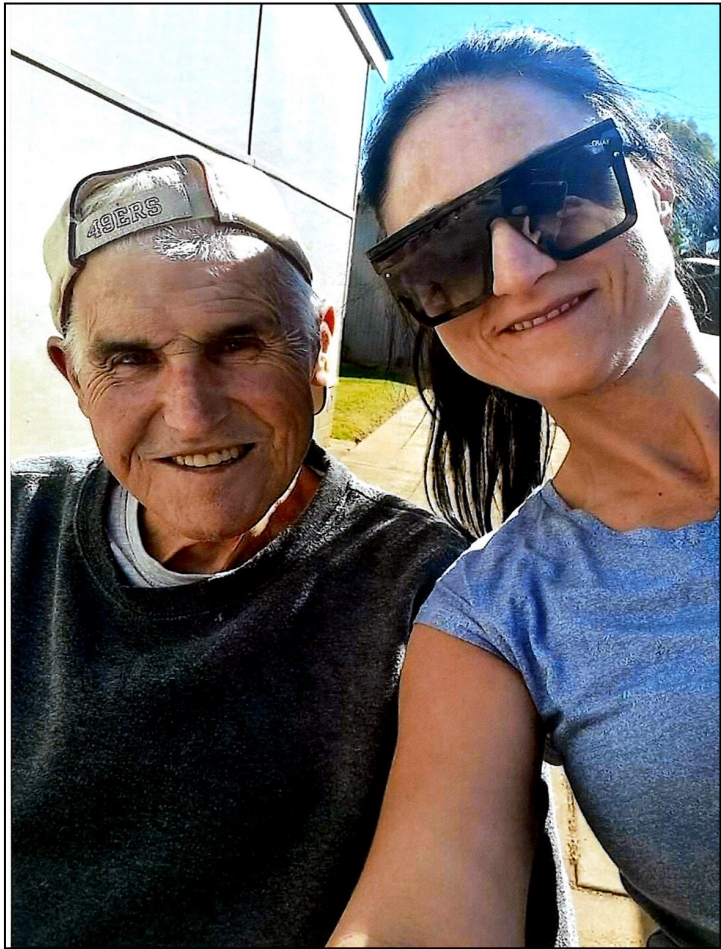
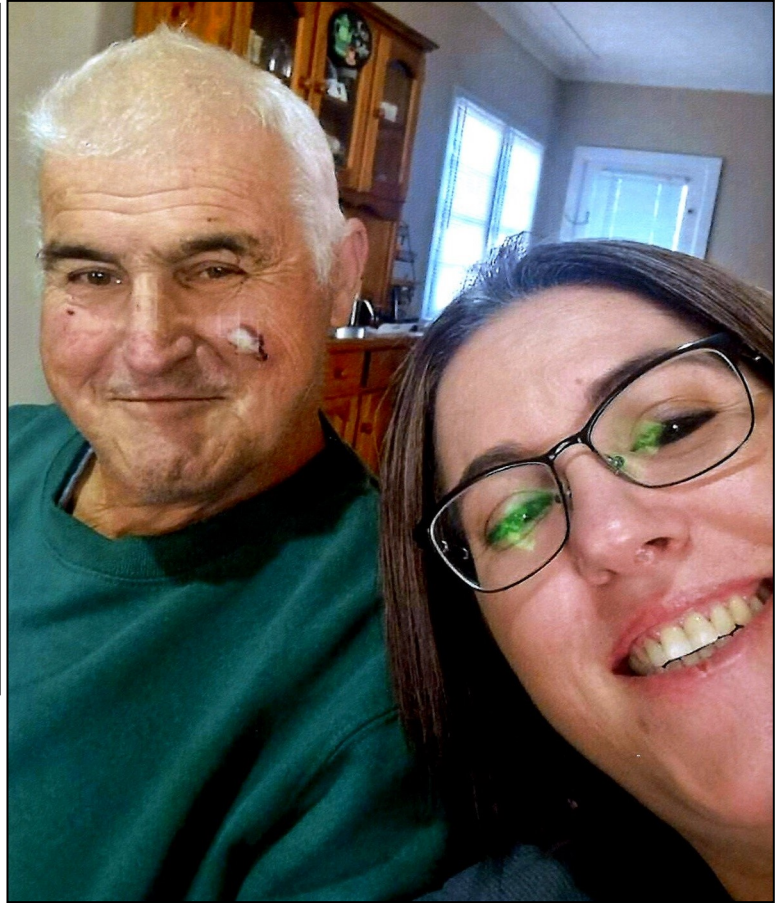
