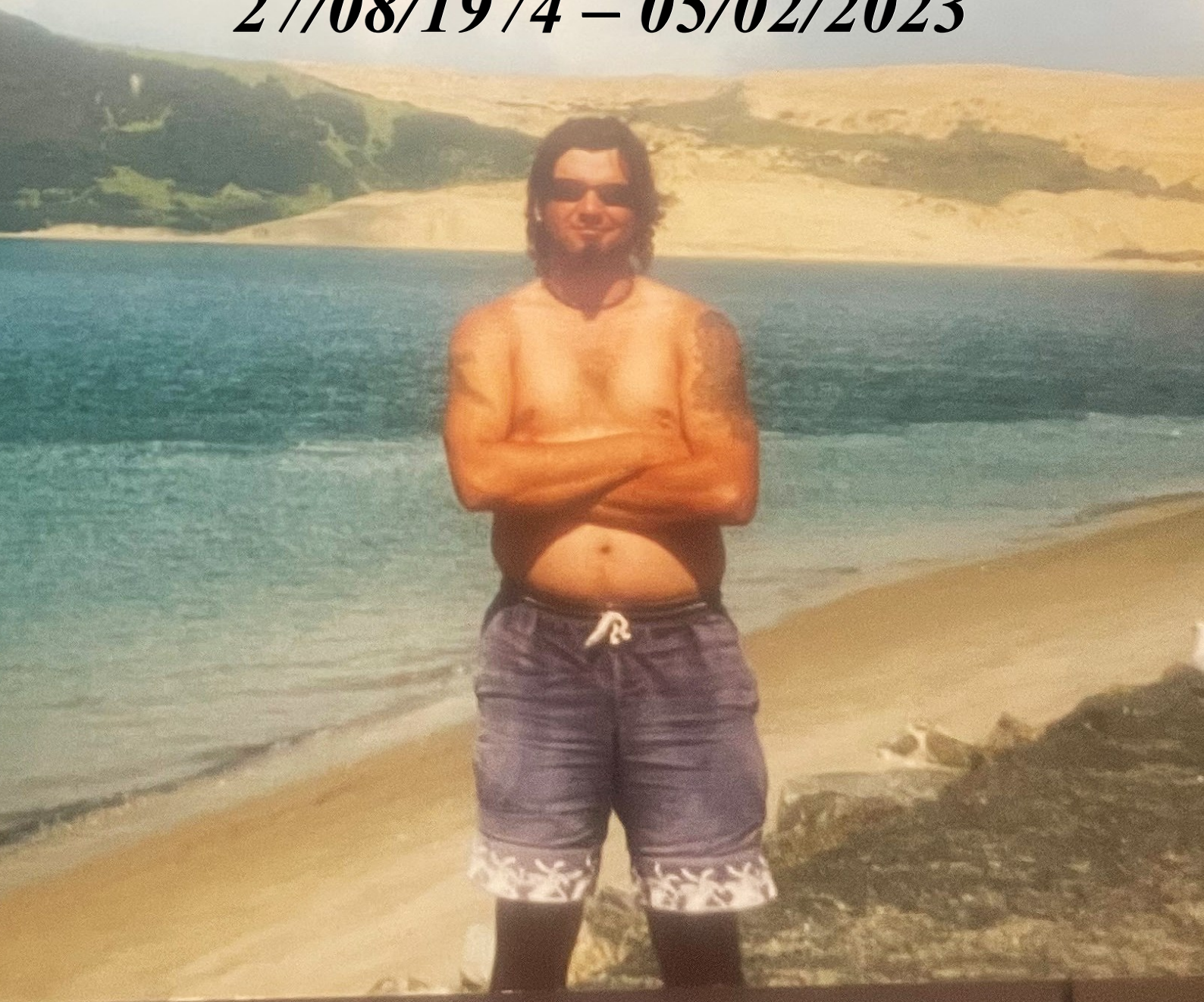

Gavin loved watching sport, cheering on his beloved Manly Rugby Team every week, spending time listening to heavy metal music and a drink or two at the local Leagues club.

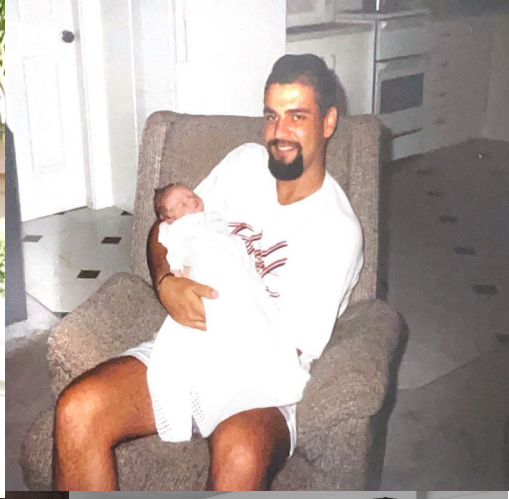
Gavin adored his boys and took great pride in his role as Grandfather to his granddaughter Laneeka – the love between them was beautiful.
