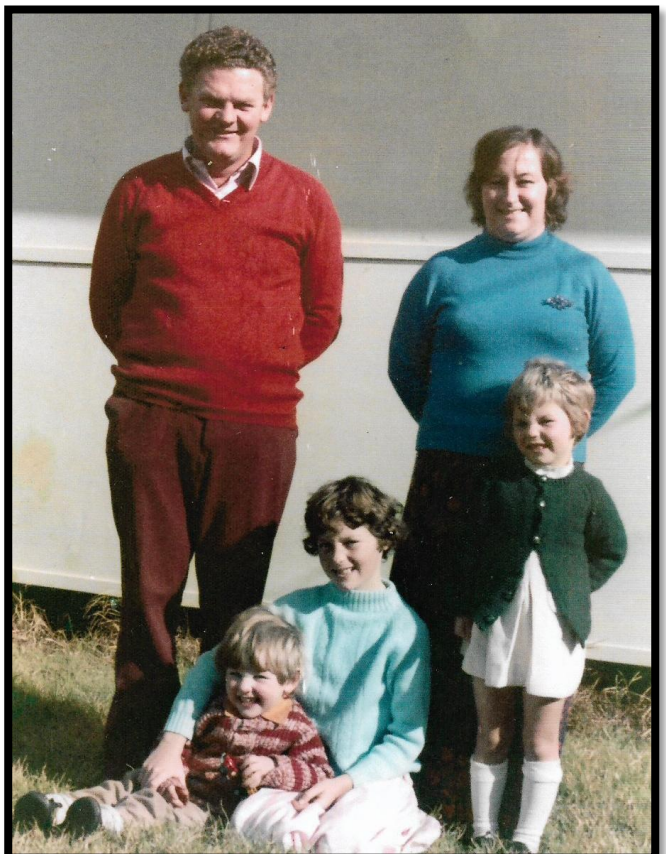
Scripture Reading

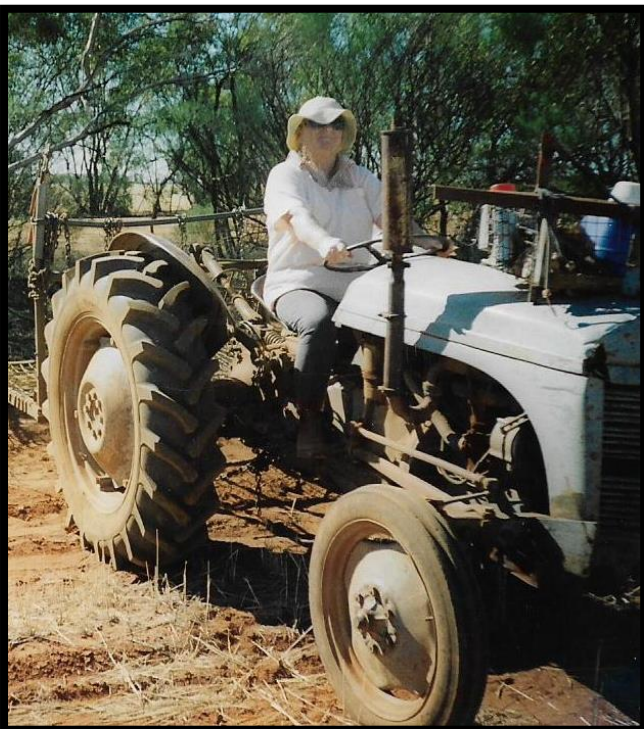
Isiah 40:28-31

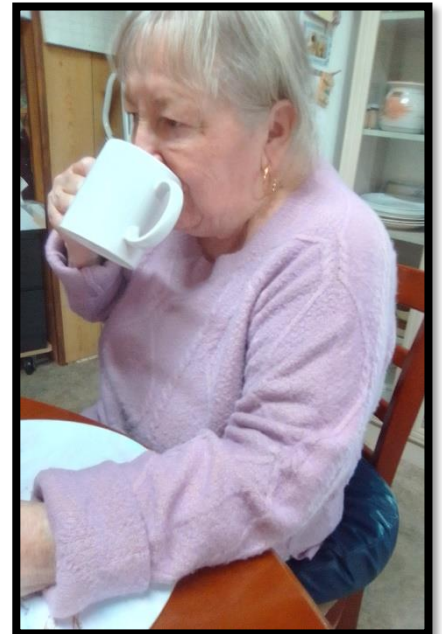
