Placing the white pall on the casket: Jemma and Brianna

Fr Cyprian: At Kevin's baptism he was clothed with Christ symbolized in this white cloth.

Placing sample of produce: Kim and Todd

Fr Cyprian: Kevin was a good steward of God's creation.

All: May God the Creator now welcome him home to heaven.

Lighting the Paschal Candle: Acacia

Fr Cyprian: In Baptism Kevin received the light of Christ. This Light illumined his Path and guided him through Life.

All: May Christ, the eternal and unfading light, now welcome Kevin into the Kingdom of eternal light and peace.

The sprinkling with holy water, a reminder of the waters of baptism: Anthony

Fr Cyprian: In the waters of baptism Kevin died with Christ and rose with him in glory.

In the sure and certain hope that, together with all who have died in Christ,





RECESSIONAL SONG – ‘You Raise Me Up’





