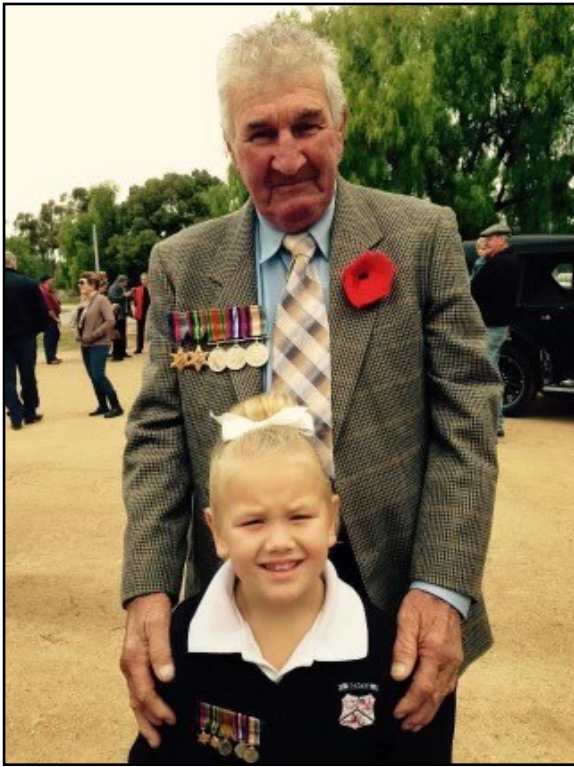

Kevin Rowston, after leaving the field at Turvey Park last Sunday had to seek medical attention for a badly cut eye.

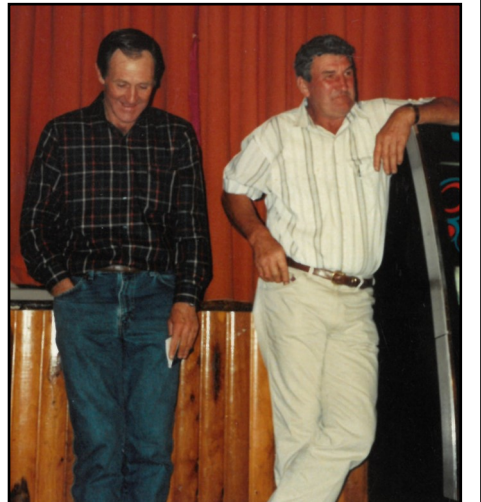
Most though Kev. would probably miss today's game but he's here and rarin' to go. Hope you have got your kickin' boots on Kev. we'll need plenty of goals.
