And keep his rig on the go.

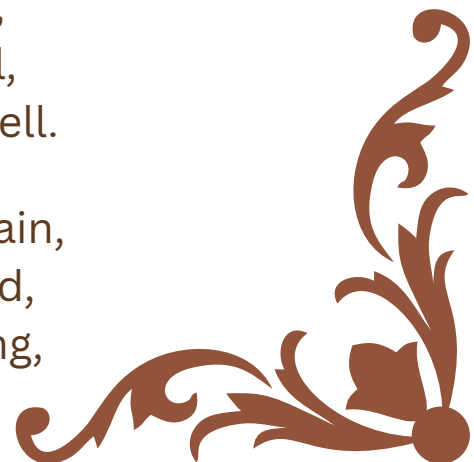
He'd watch the sunrise in the east,
