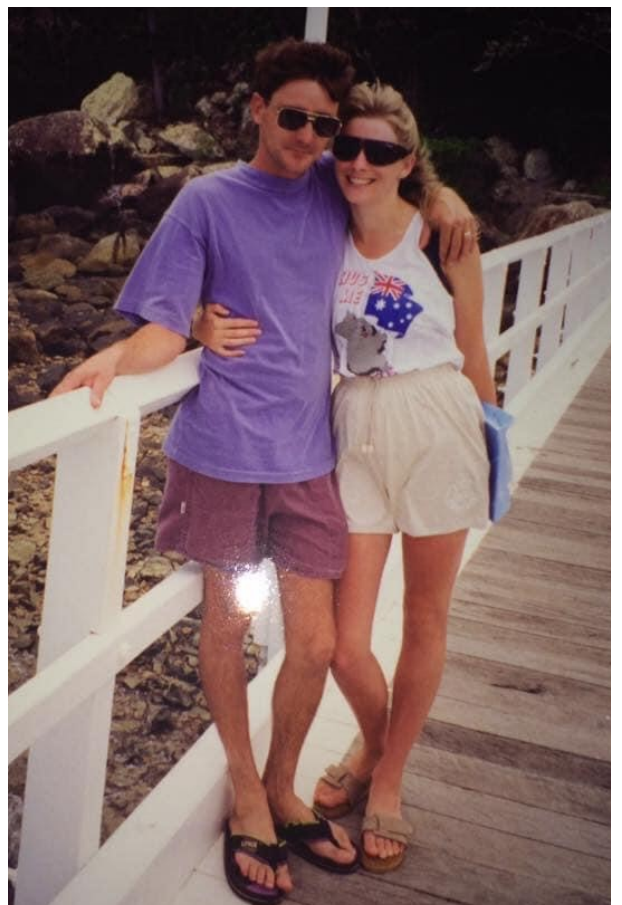
What I'd give if I could say "Hello Dad" In the same old way.
