Part of the legend of Led Zeppelin revolves around one of their most iconic logos - Icarus. According to ancient Greek mythology, Icarus was the son of the master craftsman Daedalus, who had crafted wings for his son out of feathers and wax to escape from Crete.

In May 1974, Led Zeppelin started their record label, Swan Song Records, featuring an artist's rendition of Icarus as its mascot. In time, the Icarus symbol became synonymous with the band Led Zeppelin.

Mark loved watching and feeding native birds around his home in Coleambally. Among his personal possessions was a collection of bird feathers.
