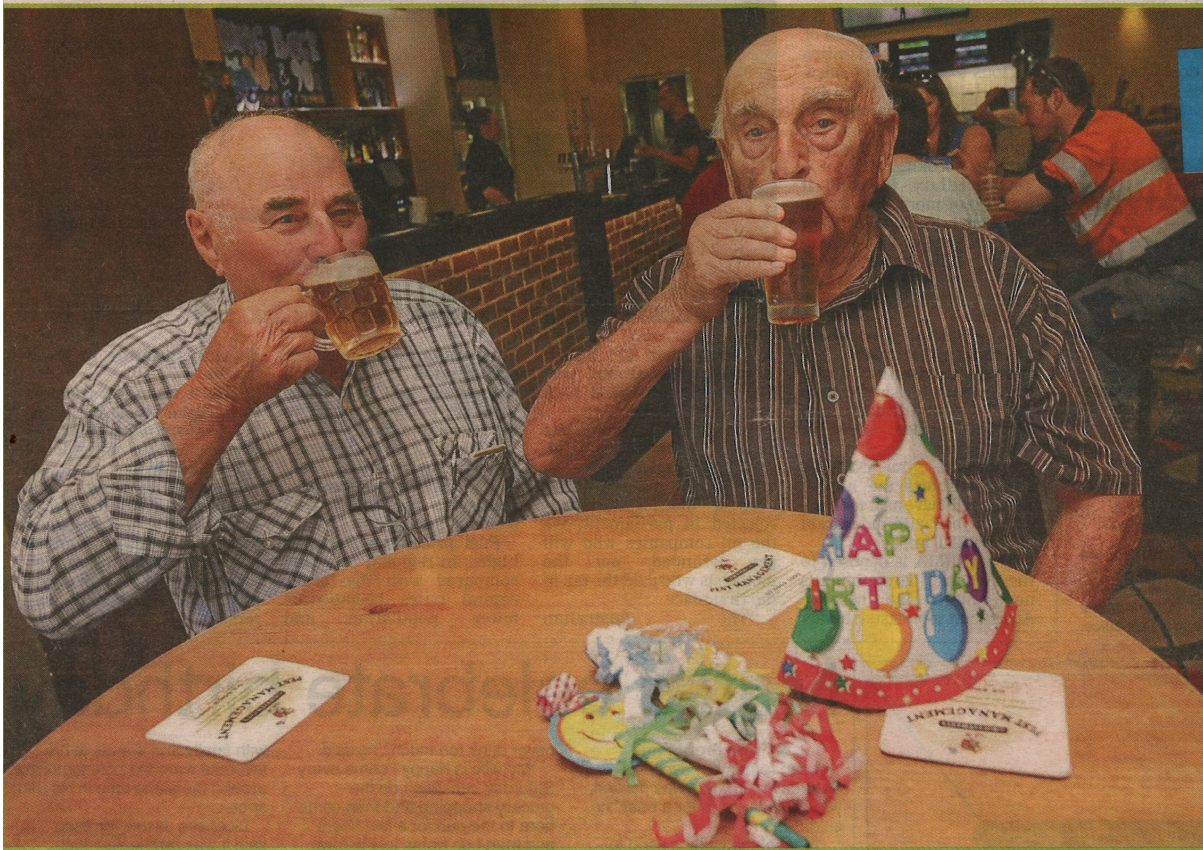

Mr Pasin, who turns 95 today, was just 19 when the pub was built.

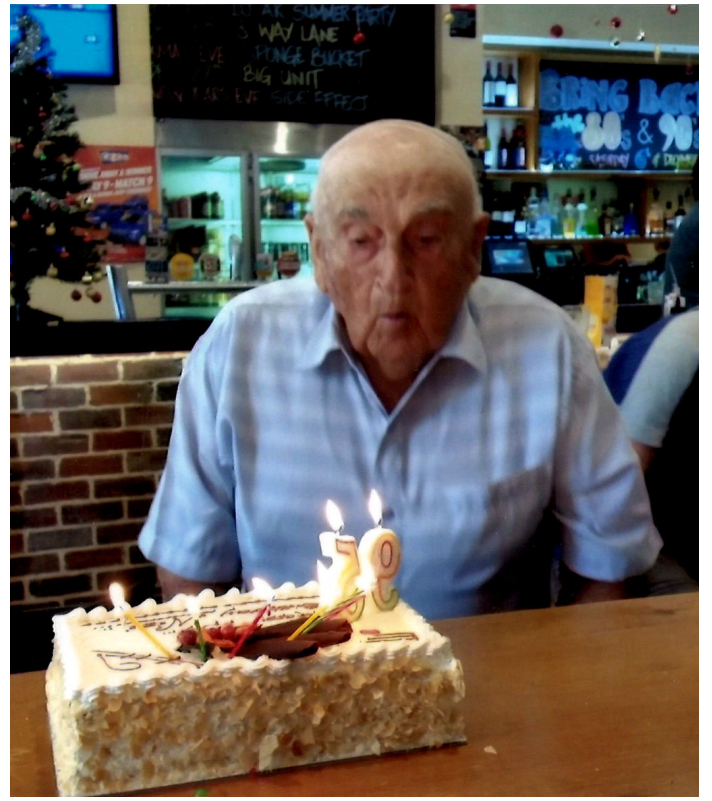
He has been going to the pub for a total of 76 years and has seen 11 different licensees come and go since it opened in 1938.
