Clare: For the family and friends of Pat, that they may be consoled in their grief by the Lord, who wept at the death of his friend Lazarus.

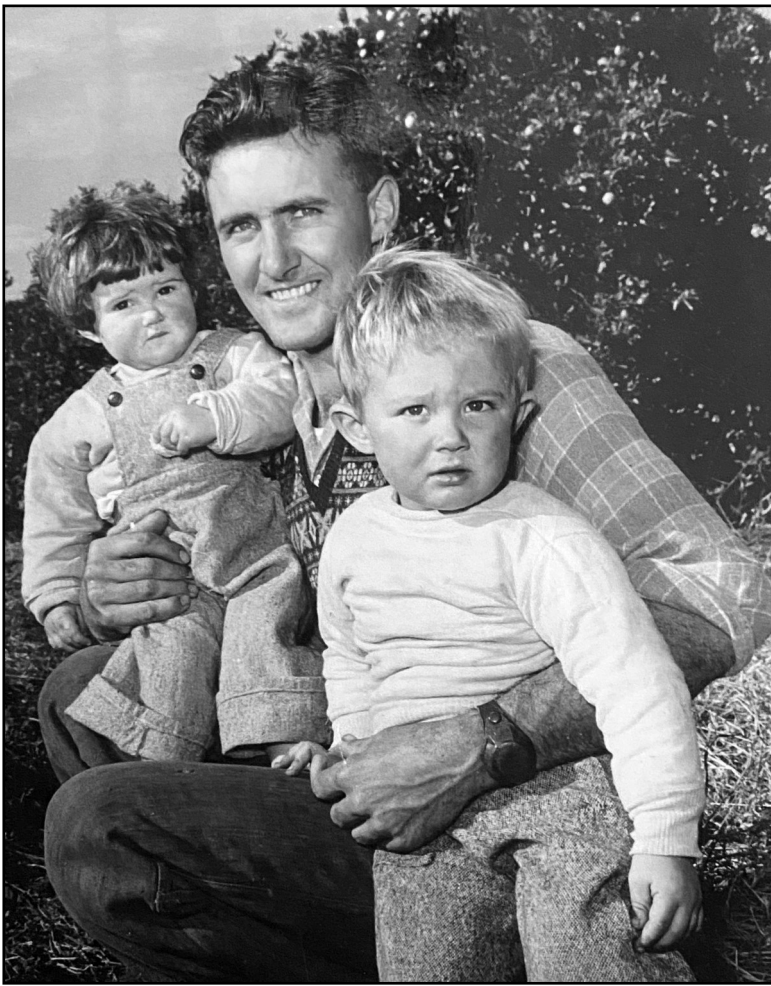

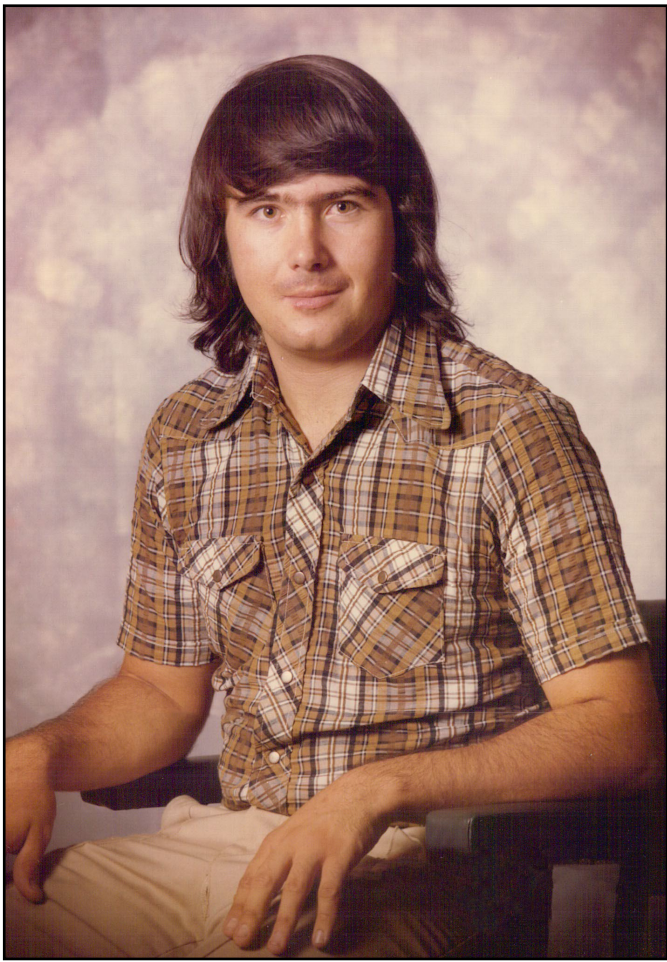
ALL: Lord, hear our prayer.
