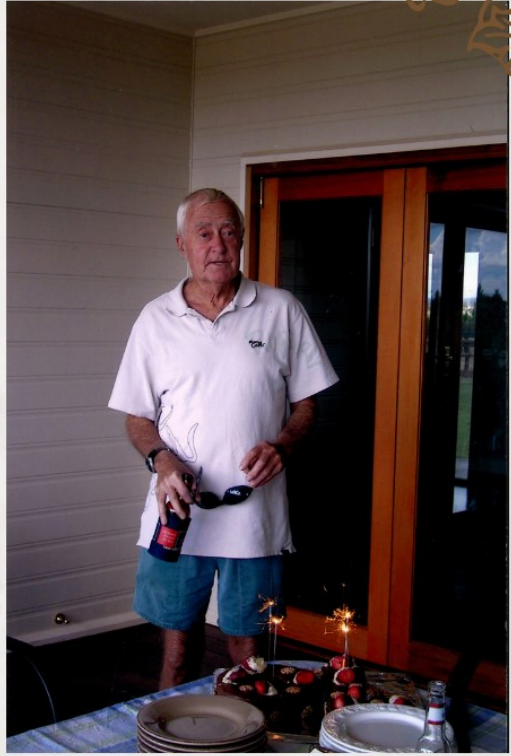












You're My Guest In Thought
