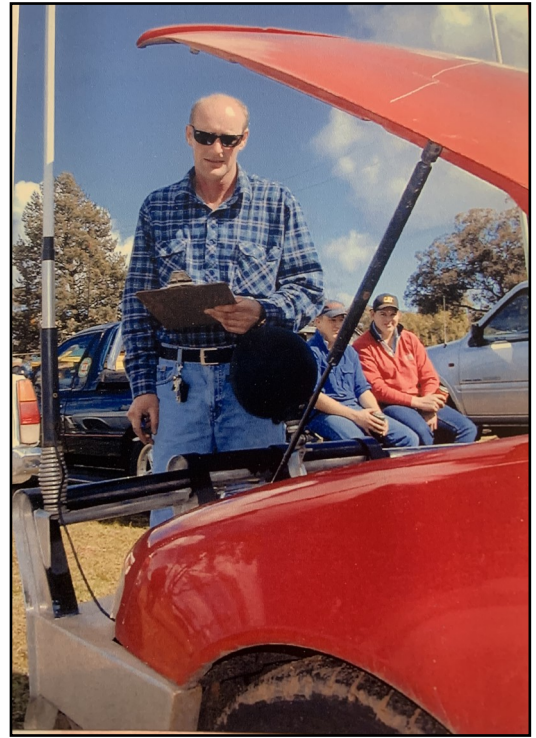

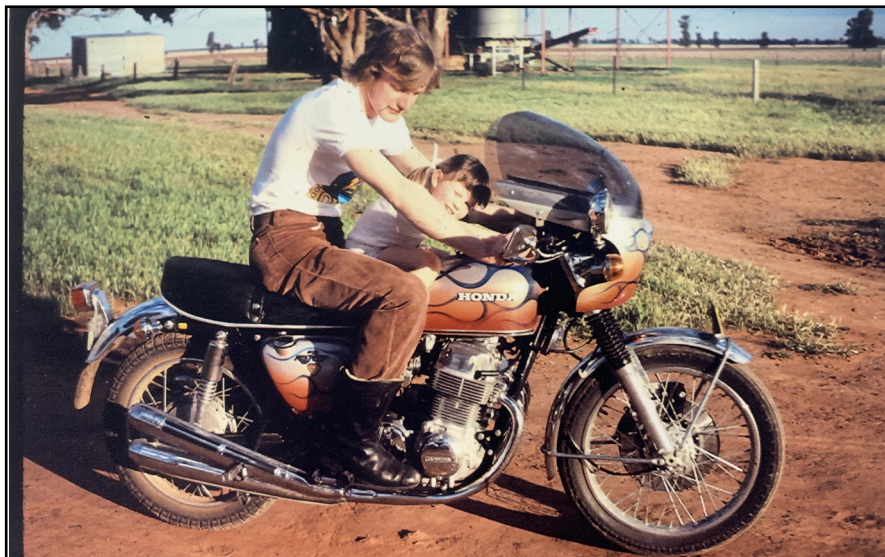












Miss me -But Let Me Go
